

RESOLUTION NO. 21, SERIES OF 2012
ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE FREMONT COUNTY
FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION REGULATIONS
DATED JANUARY 1, 2012

WHEREAS, Fremont County is authorized pursuant to the authority contained in Title 24, Article 65.1, Colorado Revised Statutes 1973, as amended, and Title 30, Article 28, Colorado Revised Statutes 1973 to designate certain natural hazard areas as areas of state interest and to regulate land use within such areas; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 38, Series of 2011, Adopting Revised Fremont County Flood Damage Prevention Regulations, which became effective January 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, The Flood Damage Prevention Regulations require amendments to ensure consistency with the revised Federal Emergency Management Agency's Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report, which shall become effective as of July 3, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Fremont County Board of Commissioners finds that the proposed amendments are appropriate and necessary; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed amendments was held by the Board of County Commissioners on the 22nd day of May, 2012, notice of which was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county, at least thirty and no more than sixty days prior to the date of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, due consideration has been given to the comments received at said public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Fremont County that:

1. The Fremont County Flood Damage Prevention Regulations, as adopted by Resolution Number 38, Series of 2011, and which became effective January 1, 2012, are hereby amended to adopt and approve the flood hazard areas within Fremont County, Colorado, as shown on the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM),(effective date July 3, 2012) which are hereby re-designated as matters of state interest in accordance with the provisions of Title 24, Article 65.1, and Title 30, Article 28, Colorado Revised Statutes.
2. The July 3, 2012 FIRM and the July 3, 2012 Flood Insurance Study report are hereby adopted as part of the Fremont County Flood Damage Prevention Regulations.
3. This Resolution and the Amendments set forth herein shall be effective on July 3, 2012, and shall continue in full force and effect until further formal modification by the Board of County Commissioners for Fremont County.
