The Board of Commissioners of the County of Fremont, State of Colorado, met in Special Session on April 19th, 2011, 615 Macon Avenue, Room LL3 Fremont County Administration Building, Canon City, Colorado. Commission Chair Edward Norden called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M.

Commissioner Bell moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Stiehl seconded the motion. Upon vote: Commissioner Bell, aye; Commissioner Stiehl, aye; Commissioner Norden, aye. The motion carried.

Commissioner Norden presented the dates and events on the applications for the Canon City Rodeo Association to be held at the Rodeo Grounds at 1925 S. 9th Street.

Boyd Canterbury, President of the Canon City Rodeo Association explained to the Board they will be selling Keg Beer at the Blossom Weekend Rodeo, and canned beer at the rest of the events. He said it will be cheaper to sell the canned beer as they can return the un-opened cans to the supplier after the events are finished. Canterbury noted they will have the Colorado Mounted Rangers for security as well as additional security. They will only sell one beer to one person at a time, unless the other person they are purchasing beer for is in sight. Boyd said he hopes this will be a good year as they have lots of events planned. There will be live music on the night of June 18th, but that is the only event with live music. The August Rodeo has 340 cowboys registered so far and should be a huge event as it is the last rodeo before the National Finals. Commissioner Norden asked the Clerk if the paperwork was complete and the proper posting had been done. Blauser replied yes the paperwork is in order. She said they did post, and provided pictures of the posting to the Commissioners. Canterbury presented the posters to the Board as well. Commissioner Stiehl asked if we had a copy of their insurance. Boyd said he will get a copy to us as soon as it is issued from Sunflower Insurance in the next few days.

Commissioner Norden asked if they will be serving beer on both sides of the arena. Boyd said yes, beer will be sold at the main concession stand, and at a beer wagon across the arena. Norden asked if people would be going around the grand stand selling beer. Boyd said no. Commissioner Bell asked who will be in charge of the liquor sales. Boyd answered Julie Lake will be at the main concession stand, and Heather will be at the beer wagon. Bell asked if they are paid employees or volunteers. Boyd replied they are volunteers who work only for tips. Norden asked if alcohol will be allowed in the chute area. Boyd answered no beer will be allowed in the chute area. Norden asked if the gate areas will be patrolled by security. Boyd said last year Don Hansen was in charge of security and he will be meeting with him again about security for this year. Boyd explained there will be mounted horsemen at the gate areas. He said last year some juveniles tried to sneak in from the adjacent carnival, but security caught them. They will patrol all areas to prevent any problems.

Commissioner Bell moved to approve the four Special Events Liquor Licenses for the Canon City Rodeo Association for four separate events on 10 separate dates as follows: May 6, May 7, June 3, June 10, June 17, June 18, and June 24 of 2011. Commissioner Stiehl seconded the motion. Upon Vote: Commissioner Bell, aye; Commissioner Stiehl, aye; Commissioner Norden, aye. The motion carried.

Chairman Norden adjourned the meeting at 10:10 A.M.
