NEW BUSINESS

1. In consideration of a bid award for the 911 Call Center renovation on 4th floor of the Judicial Building. Representative: George Sugars, County Manager

County Manager Sugars said that seven bids were received for this project. They range in price from \$807,700 to \$948,889. All of the bids were over the amount estimated for this project. Mr. Sugars explained Reilly, Johnson & Associates is currently in the process of reviewing the two lowest bids for potential costs that can be reduced. The two lowest bidders are H.W. Houston of Pueblo and Golden Triangle Construction of Colorado Springs. Mr. Sugars suggested this item be tabled until the next Commissioners Meeting in hopes that one of the bidders will come in closer to the budget amount.

Commissioner Bell moved to table the bid award for the 911 Call Center renovations until the November 10th Board of County Commissioners Meeting. Commissioner Norden seconded the motion. Upon Vote: Commissioner Bell, aye; Commissioner Norden, aye; Commissioner Payne, aye. The motion carried.
