SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of the County of Fremont, State of Colorado, met in Special Session on December 21st, 2010, 615 Macon Avenue, Room LL3 Fremont County Administration Building, Canon City, Colorado. Commission Chair Edward Norden called the meeting to order at 9:30 A.M.

Also present, George Sugars County Manager, and Jody Blausen of the Clerk and Records Office.

Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Commissioner Lasha moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Norden seconded the motion. Upon Vote: Commissioner Lasha, aye; Commissioner Norden, aye. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

1. 2010 Certification of Fremont County 2011 Mill Levies

Dana Angel, County Finance Officer presented a summary of the 2011 Mill Levies. He explained the different entities have until December 15th to report their mill levies. Dana said the County only has until December 22nd to certify the mill levies which does not allow much time to create the report. Dana noted page #2 of the report summarizes the entire report. The total valuation and revenue will be \$26,266,918 which is \$283,000 less than last year. Commissioner Norden asked Dana if the \$283,000 less was due to the minor reduction in mill levies. Dana replied some of the mill levies may be less due to Tabor and some are less due to the overall decrease in value in Fremont County. Dana said page #3 lists the School Districts and page #4 is for County Purposes. Cities and Towns are listed on page #5. Title 32 Statutory Districts with One or More Bond Levies would be on page #6, but there are not any in Fremont County. Dana noted page #7A begins Other Local Improvement and Service Districts and is continued on page #7B and summarized on page #7C. Dana stated page #8 is for Tax Increment Breakdown, but does not apply to Fremont County. Commissioner Norden asked Dana about the problem they had with Penrose Water District in previous years. Dana explained they have 1.686 mills with 3.0 mills designated for water so there should not be an issue with them. Commissioner Norden noted Fourmile Ranch Metro District had a high mill levy. Dana replied they do have a high mill levy which makes the taxes rather high in that area. George Sugars asked Dana if he could review page #3 and #4 as there is a minor discrepancy with the summary on page #2. Dana said he would get it corrected immediately. Commissioner Norden asked Dana where else the certified list goes besides the County Assessor and the State. Dana said the County Treasurer, The County Assessor, The Colorado Department of Education, The Colorado Division of Property Taxation, and The Division of Local Affairs all get a copy of the certified list. Commissioner Lasha moved to approve the 2010 Certification of Fremont County 2011 Mill Levies with the minor corrections as Resolution #65. Commissioner Norden seconded the motion. Upon Vote: Commissioner Lasha, aye; Commissioner Norden, aye. The motion carried.

Commissioner Norden adjourned the meeting at 9:45 A.M.
