RE: County Manager Report

On Thursday, August 25 Commissioner Norden and I attended the CCI Mountain District Meeting in Edwards, CO. We received an update on proposed legislature and changes that may be coming down the pipeline.

On Thursday, September 8 I attended the Area Manager's Luncheon. This group is composed of Managers/Administrators from various governmental entities in Fremont County. It is a great group to network in and see what is going on throughout the community.

On Tuesday, September 20 we met with representatives from our Tyler Incode Version X Financial System to discuss changes in the software and determine what our future needs with the software may be. They discussed training options and information that is available to the users.

On Tuesday, September 20 the Commissioners, Heritage Commission, various community members and I attended a meeting with a representative from the state to discuss Certified Local Governments. This would allow homes, buildings, and landmarks to be classified as historical, which would open up grant funding and other options for the owners of the property. These discussions will continue in the future.

On Thursday, September 21 I attended the Finance Officer's Luncheon. This group is composed of Finance Officers/Directors from various governmental entities in Fremont County. It is a great group to network in and see what is going on throughout the community.

On Monday, September 27 the Commissioners and I met with members of the City of Canon City Council for our monthly meeting.

#### Current County Projects:

- Pathfinder Park Water Line – In Progress – The list of supplies has been compiled and ordered. The Road and Bridge Department will begin the project in the next few weeks. Tommy has installed some PVC pipe so we can monitor the water levels throughout the project area.
- Pathfinder Park Parking Lot – In Progress – The Fremont County Department of Transportation will be working over the next few months to level the parking lot out and improve the drainage
- Fremont County Airport Modular Installation for Colorado Fire Command Center – In Progress – The contractor has been working on the project and is expected to be finished the middle of October.

- War Memorial Park – There are some dead trees in the park that we will be removing and replacing and we will be looking at options on getting a drip system installed for the new trees. We will be adding some additional trees to try to provide shade over the “In God We Trust” letters.
- Sheriff Jail Kitchen/Laundry/Security Upgrade – In Progress – The project was awarded to Nunn Construction. Construction is underway and is expected to be completed the end of December.
- Integrate the Sheriff Department and DHS on ESS Time Reporting System – In Progress – The Sheriff Department has been integrated and we are working out some minor issues. The next step will be it integrate DHS.
- Budget – We are currently compiling the budget and will finalize it over the next month. We will have a Public Hearing on November 8 and plan to adopt the budget December 20.
