

Attachment J: Larger group Gatherings

Larger Group Gatherings (e.g. weddings, receptions, funerals, graduation ceremonies, and LPHA approved scheduled events) may be allowed under strict adherence to the following criteria.

- All large group events should be scheduled and seek Local Public Health approval to ensure safety measures are being properly implemented.
- Social distancing of 6 feet must be adhered to.
- All participants shall be asked if they are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 and shall not be allowed to be present if they are.
- Everyone shall be required to wear face coverings.
- Post signs at entrances regarding face coverings, and post signs throughout the facility as needed to remind guests of social distancing and proper hygiene.
- Outdoor venues and gatherings must be limited to no more than 250 people not including staff and or volunteers
- Indoor group gatherings must be limited to no more than 50 people not including staff and or volunteers
- Perform environmental cleaning and disinfection of bathrooms and high touch surfaces every two hours and maintain a cleaning log.
- Catered Food services shall follow the same safety guidelines set forth for restaurants such as, wearing gloves and masks, following social distancing of at least 6ft, staff handling dirty dishes must wear gloves and an apron
- Only food prepared under a retail food license shall be allowed
- No self-service buffets shall be allowed
- Monitor employees at the beginning of each shift for one of the following symptoms:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath/difficulty breathingOr two or more of the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Repeated shaking with Chills
 - Muscle Pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell**Symptomatic employees MUST be excluded from the workplace**
- Employees shall be required to wear a non-medical cloth face covering over the nose and mouth, individuals that cannot wear a mask shall not be permitted to work at this time.
