- Driveway shall not allow drainage onto County Right-of-Way.
- Culverts shall be set on a grade which will allow for proper drainage.
- Culverts shall be corrugated metal or material of equivalent strength & construction.

- With the issuance of this address, **Fremont County in NO way accepts responsibility** for the maintenance of the roadway or access to the property.

- Fremont County is responsible for issuing addresses only for the properties in the **unincorporated** areas of Fremont County. To obtain addresses inside incorporated city limits of Brookside, Coal Creek, Canon City, Florence, Rockvale, or Williamsburg, you will need to contact those municipalities directly.
- All lands within Fremont County are subject to Zoning and Building regulations.
