1. Reconsideration of Ambulance Licensing Representative: Jill Filer, Fremont County Emergency Management Director

Jill Filer explained that all 5 ambulance agencies meet the regulations for ALS even though only American Medical Response was approved as ALS and the others as BLS.

County Attorney Jackson said that it is not up to the County to make sure staffing and other requirements are being met to qualify for ALS service and/or billing. However, if an agency is not licensed as ALS but performs ALS services, they cannot bill accordingly. If they are only licensed as BLS and provide ALS services/staff, they are not going to be paid properly and will be out the addition money.

Commissioner McFall moved to approve the change in licensing from BLS to ALS for Penrose, Florence, Deer Mountain and AVA. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Upon Vote: Commissioner McFall, aye; Commissioner Bell, aye; Commissioner Payne, aye. The motion carried.
