

Adopt a Road Agreement Provisions

- ✓ **Participating Organizations/Groups:**
 - ✓ All participating group members will have attended a safety meeting in which all members will have viewed the “Spruce up Colorado Volunteer Safety Video and Meth Lab Waste Recognition Video” prior to any planned pick-ups. It is the responsibility of the group/organization coordinator to arrange for such a meeting. Potential dangers involved while participating in this program on County roads can include, but are not limited to: high speed traffic, potentially noxious plants, broken glass, hazardous materials, sharp metal, and potentially harmful wildlife such as snakes and skunks.
 - ✓ The group will notify their assigned FCDOT contact within 30 days prior to a planned pickup so that trash may be removed by FCDOT employees in a timely manner.
 - ✓ Participating group agrees to restrict program activities to the area of right-of-way off the traveled portion of the roadway. (Stay off of the asphalt)
 - ✓ While performing activities on the right-of-way, the method, manner, and appearance of the participants will not in any way distract, disrupt, or adversely affect the flow of traffic. Participants may not display messages, carry banners, or advertise their business affiliation or cause.
 - ✓ FCDOT prohibits the possession, consumption, or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while performing work or litter pick up on County rights-of-way.
 - ✓ This contract is not to be considered a contract of employment with the County of Fremont or any of its agencies therein, either expressly or implied.
 - ✓ The group/organization shall provide one competent adult supervisor for every eight (8) participants between 13-17 years of age and one competent adult supervisor to every four participants between 6-12 years of age. No one under the age of six (6) will be allowed to participate in the program.
 - ✓ Program activities will be between the hours of one hour after sunrise to one hour before sunset and not during inclement weather. This is in an effort to promote safety for all participants, as well as all citizens.
 - ✓ The group/organization will notify FDCOT contact in the event of any group supervisor/leader change and/or change of address within 30 days.

- ✓ **The Fremont County Department of Transportation:**
 - Determines the specific section of right-of-way to be adopted.
 - Installs and maintains signs (if desired by group).
 - Provides group/organization members with trash bags and safety vests.
 - Removes and disposes of filled trash bags.
 - **Disposal is to include roadside trash only. No appliances, tires, furniture or other large objects will be accepted or removed. Abuse of this provision will lead to termination of this agreement and any costs incurred will be the responsibility of the participant (s).**
 - Provides “Spruce up Colorado” and “Meth Lab Waste Recognition” volunteer safety videos to group coordinator.
 - Reserves the right to cancel any agreement due to failure to meet provisions of the program or for safety reasons.
 - Reserves the right to request name and legal address of all participating group members/participants.
